

RECENT PROGRAMS...

Sept 23 – Rob Boyle, Executive Director of *Fumiture Bank for Southeastern Michigan* (based in Pontiac) spoke about the many important services his organization provides to families in Oakland / Macomb Counties - for over 40 years, furnishing hope and establishing a stable home to over 4,000 families in need by providing: 2600 tables around which families can gather; 2300 mattresses/beds to keep children from sleeping on the floor; 200 cribs for newborns and infants to sleep safely; 200 sofas and dressers; and over 500 appliances to store and cook meals, and clean clothes. They collaborate with other human services organizations to help children, infants and newborns, victims of domestic violence, fire, theft and floods, the home-less, those with disabilities, medical emergencies, foster parents and seniors.

Oct 7 - Awards/Installation Dinner

Oct 14 - John Scott, Oakland County Commissioner and fellow member gave us an update: The County budget is balanced, as is Keego Harbor. Property taxes are down 15-20%.

Oct 21 — Randi Sakwa, from *Our Children's Fund*, a non-profit organization, run by volunteers, with the support of the West Bloomfield School District, for the purpose of providing for children and their families in need. Since its inception in 1990, *Our Children's Fund* has granted nearly 1038 requests totaling more than \$197,471. Assistance can range from medical expenses, clothing, food, school supplies and other necessities. 100% of fundraising activities goes to these needy families. The School District provides a social worker and secretarial services.

Oct 28 – Lt. Gov. Lisa Boettcher (Lakes Area Optimist Club) visited our Club, and promises to stay in touch this year. Also spotted at the conclusion of our meeting: Past Lt.Gov Debbie Berry (Waterford Optimists) meeting with Past Governor Bob Schiller (West Bloomfield Club).
